

Children's Integrated Services (CIS) Guidelines for Use and Distribution of Outreach Materials

Goals of CIS Outreach Materials:

To publicize state and regional contact information about CIS;

How to make a referral to regional CIS Coordinators; and

To provide a more detailed description of CIS child development and family support services, which are available to families beginning in pregnancy through age six.

CIS includes nursing, family support, early childhood and family mental health, early intervention and specialized child care services.

CIS Materials include:

A rack card with a brief description of each of the CIS services for families and referring providers

A one page informational sheet that describes each of the five CIS services in more detail.

These materials states where to obtain a referral form and can be customized to include contact information for each regional CIS Coordinator; where a provider can fax a referral; and what will happen after a referral is made.

Materials may be used in pamphlet racks, mailings, handouts, conferences, etc.
