

CHILDREN'S INTEGRATED SERVICES **Menu of Services**

Children's Integrated Services (CIS) is Vermont's approach to providing coordinated child health, developmental and family support services to high needs children and their families. These services include:

Nursing and Family Support Services for prenatal and postpartum moms, infants and children aged birth to six:

Nursing and Family Support Services focuses on health promotion and well-being; support and education during pregnancy and/or childbirth, parenting and role transitions, child growth and development; promotes skills and strategies that ensure safe and healthy environments; and assists families to connect with high quality health care and other support services in their community.

Nurse Family Partnership focus on: healthy pregnancy, parent education, safety in the home, referrals for healthcare, childcare and other support services available in the community. Enrollment is for prenatal moms who are up to 28 weeks who are having their first baby.

Early Childhood and Family Mental Health provides education to families with children ages birth through six, and early childhood educators to support children's social-emotional development. Consultation and case management services are provided to families and early childhood programs to support children who have challenging behaviors.

Early Intervention is a collaborative system of early intervention services for families with children ages birth to three. This program coordinates and provides services for infants and toddlers with medical conditions or developmental delays, or who have a condition that may put them at risk for developmental delays. These services are in the child's natural environment such as the home or a community based setting like playgroups through a family-centered, coordinated system including speech and language, physical therapy, occupational therapy, developmental education and more.

Specialized Child Care Services Specialized Child Care (SCC) is part of the continuum of coordinated services offered through Children's Integrated Services (CIS) in Vermont communities. SCC offers an array of services and supports to families and children with identified specialized child care needs, and to child care providers and CIS specialists working with families to assure that these children experience success in child care settings that meet their needs. Specialized Child Care providers have made a commitment to providing the best quality care to vulnerable children in their care. They agree to continuous professional development that targets the social emotional development of children to enhance and improve their skills in a safe and supportive environment
